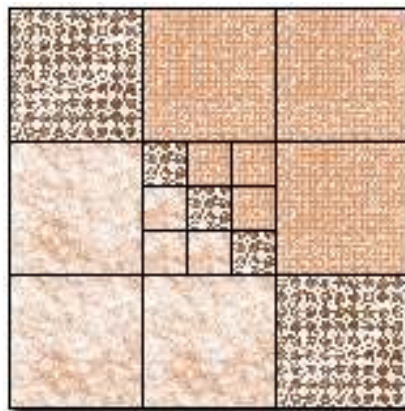

## MIDDLE SCHOOL REQUEST


